Dear Mr. & Mrs. Sofia,

Thank you for taking to time to contact our office. After working with Denise Wilhite' Thomas of Operation Reach and Bill Nolan of Cal Vet, your home loan was reinstated with Cal Vet.

The conditions of your reinstatement were worked out between Mrs. Thomas and Mr. Nolan on your behalf. It was concluded that upon signing a new contract and paying the agreed amount per month, your family would continue to reside in your home.

In April, after receiving the contract from Cal Vet, you contacted Mrs. Thomas and requested that the language requiring Cal Vet to re-evaluate your loan after six months be removed. Your concerns were conveyed to Mr. Nolan and he assured me that a re-evaluation of a loan is protocol and not directed exclusively at you.

A few weeks later you and I spoke on the phone regarding the re-evaluation and I assured you that this is protocol for all who have a contract with Cal Vet. At that time I also informed you that you needed to sign your contract and send it along with your payment, or Cal Vet will restart the eviction process against your home.
